As we come to an end of our time in Uruguay, please continue praying for us. We are feeling great sadness as we say goodbye. At the same time, we're trying to navigate through the logistics of moving from Uruguay to the United States. Also, pray for us as we trust God for where He is guiding us next. We know that God's plan is always the best plan and that He can be trusted.

In addition, we ask that you continue your investment of prayer and financial support. We will be continuing our work with Cru and are currently in the process of being reassigned. Your faithful partnership will continue to enable us to build and send Christ-centered laborers.

When we return, we'd love to meet with you and share more stories of what God has done this past year, but also share more details about our reassignment than what a letter can provide. Over the course of the next month, we will be sending out more information about our transition.

Finally, we want to thank all of you. It is because of your support, prayers, encouragement, and financial partnership that this year of ministry in Uruguay has been possible. Your generosity has caused many people to give thanks and praise to God. We appreciate you so much. Thank you for partnering with us to reach people for Christ.
