She plays with toys and blankets, rolls and scoots around (just like her big brother did), and sleeps when she is in the mood. James spends most of his days playing baseball (both inside and outside), “making” in the kitchen with mom, reading books in his rocking chair, playing his guitar and singing along with the music, and doing puzzles. He is a great helper with bringing toys, pacifiers, and diapers to Abigail. He even carries our keys to unlock the door, insists on holding the door open, presses the buttons in the elevator, and he loads and unloads the laundry.

And at the end of everyday when we cuddle up in our rocking chair to read stories and say goodnight, James asks to say five phrases, starting with “God is good...”
