Over the weekend of November 8th-10th, students gathered in the Wisconsin Dells for the Legacy Conference. This weekend was designed specifically for ethnic minority college students to come together and hear not only about who God made them in their ethnic and cultural identity, but also how that identity is a unique lens through which the gospel can shine and be shown back to other people in the world.

Picture a Latino student hearing a message from a Latino leader who is allowing God to make the gospel come alive in and through his unique cultural and ethnic experience. Or imagine a Hmong student, surrounded by family who are dedicated to the Shaman religion, hearing from a Hmong pastor how God transformed his life in a unique way. Or think of a black student hearing from a black Christian leader how Jesus empowered her to live for God. These are just a few of the opportunities that the Legacy conference created for people.

The Legacy conference is one strategy we are trusting God to use in order to help raise up Christ-centered ethnic minority leaders to be sent back to their college campuses and beyond. The weekend included main sessions with speakers from various ethnic and cultural backgrounds; breakout seminars on topics related to leadership, identity, and walking with God; as well as plenty of time for community and fun together.
