I asked the group if they would share some of the things they learned during the last few weeks. From January 18th to February 1st, Caleb served as a Bible Study Methods coach. This class is offered to all new staff who join with Cru (due to the pandemic, this year it was offered virtually). For two weeks, people are introduced to classic principles of biblical interpretation, learn various tools and skills to study the Bible, and then are given the chance to turn theory into practice by applying these resources to studying the book of Ephesians.

In Cru, we believe the Word is vital to a growing relationship with God. We also believe God's Word is vital to the ministry to which God has called us. This same person went on to share, "I want to continue to practice studying the Bible for myself so then I can take those next steps to really teach those who I serve to do the same. Because of how impactful this has been to me, I want to share the wealth with others."
